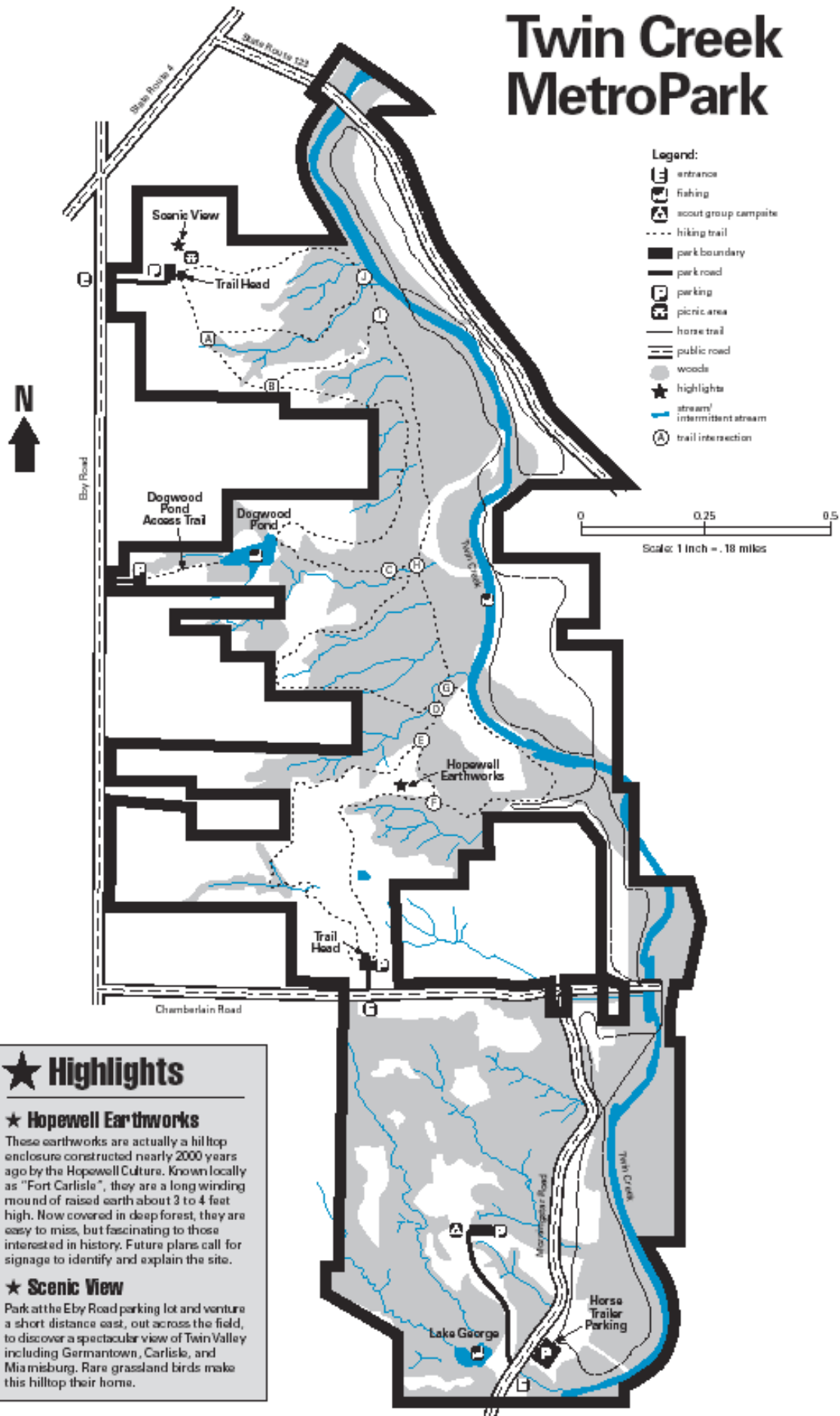


1. Head **west** on **W Central Ave/Franklin Rd/ OH-73 W** toward **Edgebrook Dr**
Continue to follow OH-73 W  3.8 mi
2. Turn **right** at **Cana St/Riley Blvd**
Continue to follow Riley Blvd  0.5 mi
3. Continue onto **N Main St**  0.4 mi
4. Turn **left** at **Kenneth Koons Blvd**  0.2 mi
5. Continue onto **Central Ave**  2.2 mi
6. Turn **left** at **Chamberlain Rd**  0.8 mi
7. Take the 3rd **left** onto **Morningstar Rd**  0.8 mi
8. Turn **right** 0.4 mi

★ Highlights

★ Hopewell Earthworks
 These earthworks are actually a hilltop enclosure constructed nearly 2000 years ago by the Hopewell Culture. Known locally as "Fort Carlisle", they are a long winding mound of raised earth about 3 to 4 feet high. Now covered in deep forest, they are easy to miss, but fascinating to those interested in history. Future plans call for signage to identify and explain the site.

★ Scenic View
 Park at the Eby Road parking lot and venture a short distance east, out across the field, to discover a spectacular view of Twin Valley including Germantown, Carlisle, and Mia misburg. Rare grassland birds make this hilltop their home.
